
## TELLING THE TIME



3:00 It's three o'clock.

3:05 It's five past three.

3:10 It's ten past three.

3:15 It's quarter past three.

3:20 It's twenty past three.

3:25 It's twenty-five past three.

3:30 It's half past three.

3:35 It's twenty-five to four.

3:40 It's twenty to four.

3:45 It's quarter to four.

3:50 It's ten to four.

3:55 It's five to four.

We use AT and TIME when giving the time of a specific event.

The party starts at three o'clock. She got to the party at a quarter to three. We use IT IS or IT'S to answer the question of what the time is currently.

It is three o'clock.

It's a quarter to three.
