

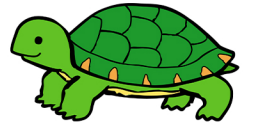
Imagine it is the year 3052. The Earth has been polluted and not taken care of. What does the Earth look like, smell like, feel like?



Describe how you can reduce waste.



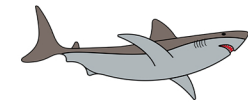
Write a silly story about a turtle that pranks a monkey for April Fool's Day.

Persuade the Easter Bunny to only bring you candy and eggs but give the rest of the world lettuce.

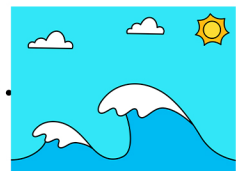
What do you think would happen if the Easter Bunny ate only chocolate for 24 hours?



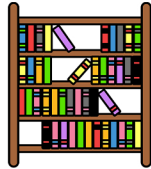
Write a creative story about a group of aliens who visit Earth and befriend a human.

How many years of school do you think kids should have? Why?



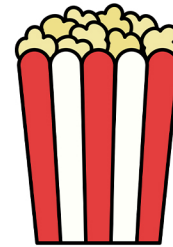
Create a make-believe pet. Describe what it looks like sounds like, and what would you name it?
