Write a story about a family that goes on a wild sleigh ride to find the perfect Christmas tree.



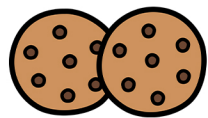
Would you rather receive one big gift or several small gifts?

How are the experiences of baking holiday cookies and making hot chocolate different?

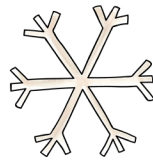
Compare the experience of decorating a gingerbread house and dressing up in a costume for Halloween.

Would you rather live at the North Pole with Santa Claus or live in a tropical beach during December?



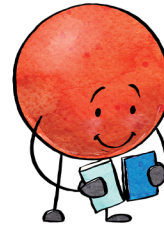
Would you rather have a pet polar bear or a pet penguin?
