


Rainy Days vs. Sunny Days

Rainy and sunny are both types of weather. They both give water to plants and animals. On both rainy and sunny days, we can play outside. Both kinds of days can be warm or cool. On rainy days, water falls from clouds, but on sunny days, the sky is clear. We use umbrellas on rainy days, while we might wear sunglasses on sunny days. Puddles form on the ground during rain, but the ground is dry in the sun. Rainy days might have thunder, while sunny days often have gentle breezes.
