COLOR

A color poem is a poem that describes a single color using your senses, emotions, and imagination.

What is a Color Poem?

A color poem is a poem about one color. You use your eyes, nose, hands, ears, and feelings to tell what that color is like.

1. Pick a Color

Choose any color you like—red, blue, green, or even a fun one like turquoise!

2. Use Your Senses

- What does the color look like? (Red is a blazing fire.)
- What does it smell like? (Yellow smells like fresh lemons.)
- What does it sound like? (Blue sounds like ocean waves crashing.)
- What does it taste like? (Orange tastes like sweet, juicy mangoes.)
- What does it feel like? (Pink feels like soft cotton candy.)

3. Write Short, Fun Lines

Each line should describe the color in a creative way.

You can use similes (as bright as the sun) or personification (Green whispers through the leaves).

4. End with a Strong Closing Line

You can wrap up by saying how the color makes you feel!

EXAMPLE

Green

Green is the whisper of the trees,
The crunch of a fresh, sour apple.
It smells like new grass after rain,
And tastes like cool mint ice cream.
Green feels soft like moss on a stone,
A color of peace, calm, and home.
