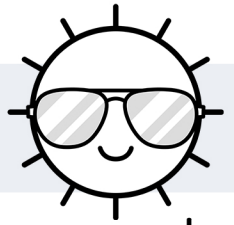


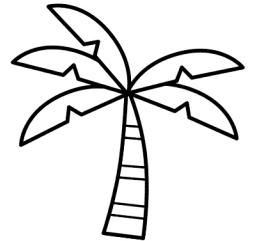

# My Super Silly Summer Splash

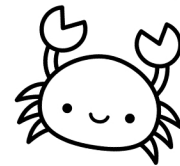


One \_\_\_\_\_ summer afternoon, \_\_\_\_\_ put
