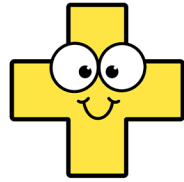
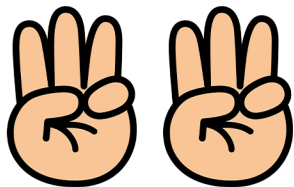


ADDITION STRATEGIES



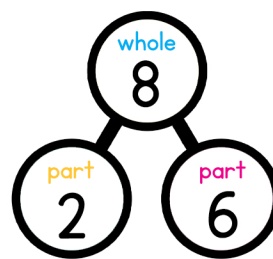
USE DOUBLES

$$3 + 3 = 6$$



Add the same number together to find the total.

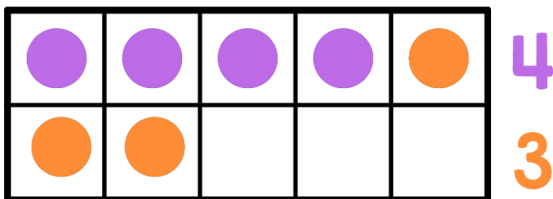
NUMBER BONDS



$$6 + 2 = 8$$

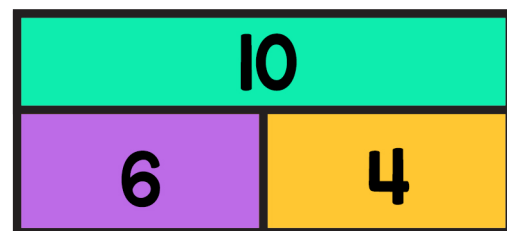
part - addends
whole - sum

TEN FRAME



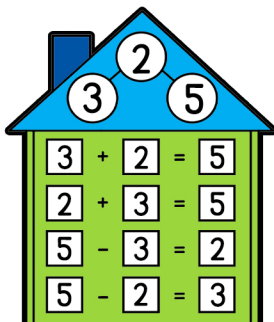
$$4 + 3 = 7$$

PART-PART-WHOLE



$$6 + 4 = 10$$

FACT FAMILIES



2 3 5

4 sets of facts using the same 3 numbers.

MAKE A TEN

Make 10: $6 + 9 = ?$ Subtract that number from the addend.

6 + 4 = 10
10 + 5 = 15

Answer:

$$6 + 9 = 15$$
