Before experimenting, find out what others already know about your question. Look in books, search kid-friendly websites (with adult help), or ask teachers and experts to gather important information about your topic .

EXAMPLE QUESTIONS

1. "What do plants need to grow?"
2. "How does sunlight help plants?"
3. "Have other scientists done experiments about plants and light?"
4. "What happens to plants that don't get enough light?"
5. "Why do magnets attract some metals but not others?"
6. "What makes some paper towels more absorbent than others?"
