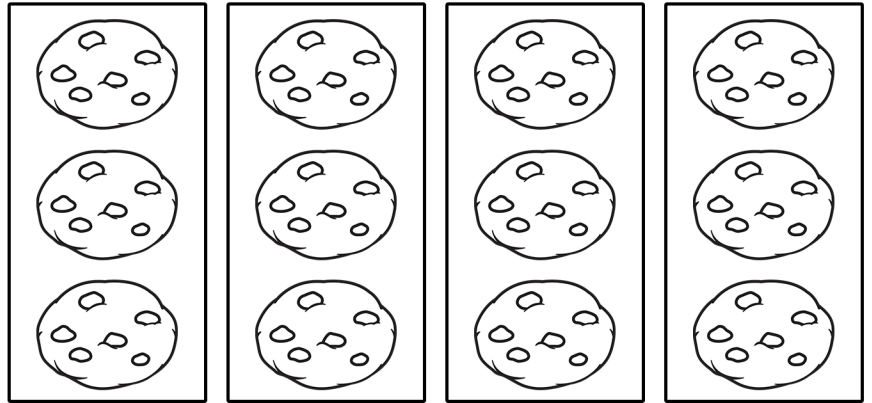
Marcus has 24 toy cars. He arranges them into 4 equal rows. How many cars are in each row?

Solve each division problem. Show your work.

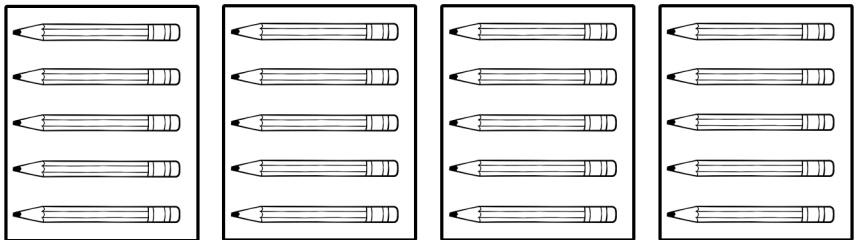
Sarah has 12 cookies. She wants to share them equally among 3 friends. How many cookies will each friend get?

$$\boxed{12} \div \boxed{3} = \boxed{4}$$



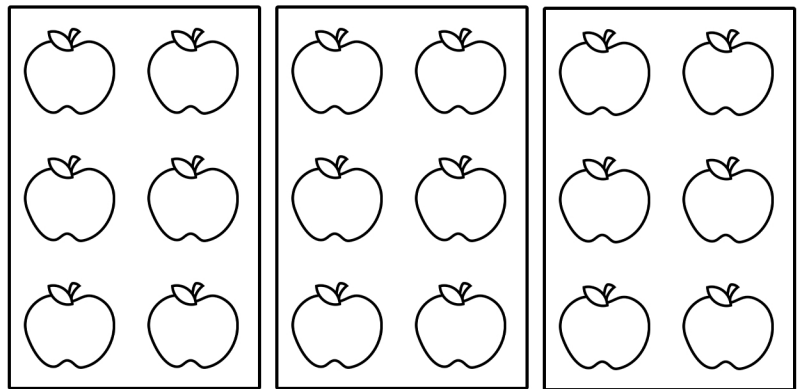
A teacher has 20 pencils. She puts them into groups of 5. How many groups can she make?

Marcus has 24 toy cars. He arranges them into 4 equal rows. How many cars are in each row?
