$$\boxed{\phantom{0}} \times \boxed{\phantom{0}} = \boxed{\phantom{0}}$$

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
There are 24 classrooms in a school. Each classroom has 3 windows. How many windows does the school have?

$$24 \times 3 = 72$$




For 5 days, Emily reads 16 pages every day. How many pages does Emily read in total?

$$5 \times 16 = 80$$



A theater has 32 rows of seats. Each row has 4 seats. How many seats are there in the theater?

$$32 \times 4 = 128$$



A factory produces 45 toys every hour for 2 hours. How many toys does the factory produce?

$$45 \times 2 = 90$$
