Some sharks can rest while swimming, turning off half their brain at a time!



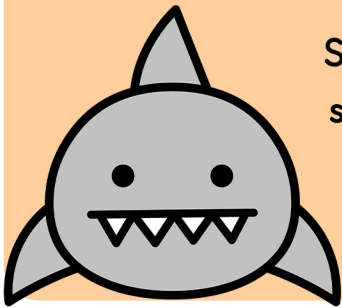
LONG LIFE!

NO EYELIDS!

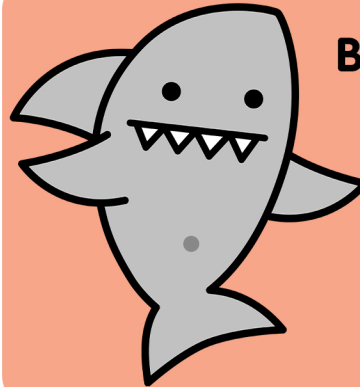
Sharks don't blink! Some roll their eyes back to protect them instead.

SILENT SWIMMERS!

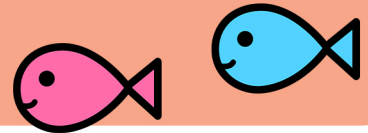


Sharks are totally silent. They don't make any sounds at all!

Baby sharks are born with a belly button, just like you!

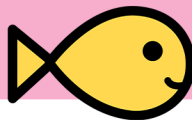


PICKY EATERS!

A shark's liver is filled with oil to help it float in the ocean!

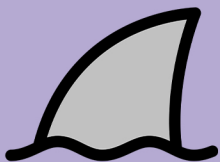


DEEP DIVERS!
