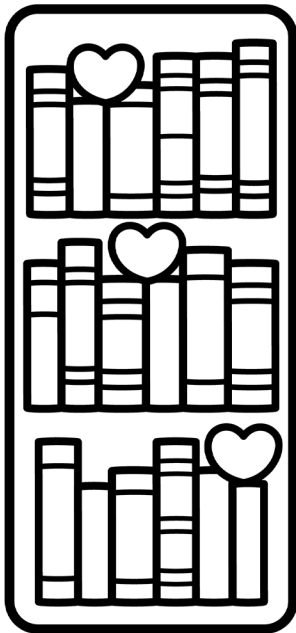
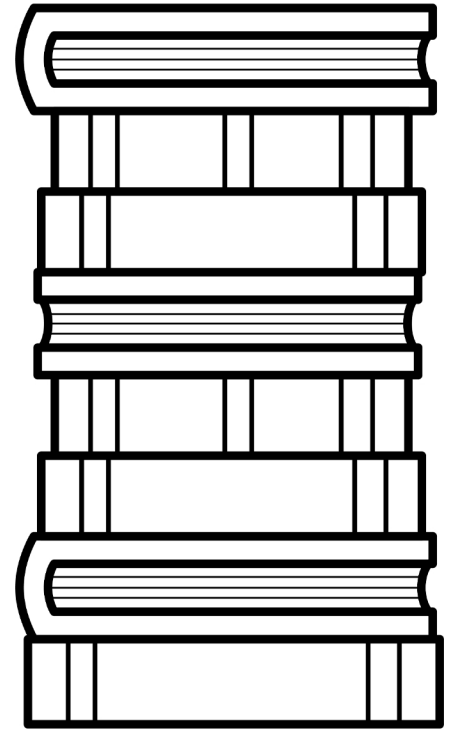


Every spring, we celebrate National Library Week! This special week is all about libraries and the amazing things they do for everyone.
