



Pumpkins are actually a fruit, not a vegetable.

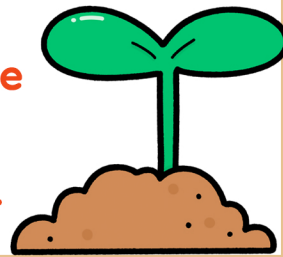
Pumpkins are made up of about 90% water.

Native Americans wove dried pumpkin strips into mats.



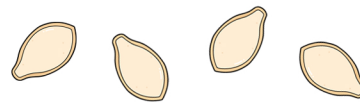
There are over 100 different varieties of pumpkins.
