

Comparative & Superlative ADVERBS

When an adverb ends in **-ly**, you use **more** or **most** before the adverb.
If you are comparing 2 things, you use **more**. If you are comparing 3 or more, you use **most**.

Adverb	Comparative (more)	Superlative (most)
carefully	more carefully	most carefully
quickly	more quickly	most quickly
quietly	more quietly	most quietly
slowly	more slowly	most slowly

EXAMPLE:

loudly
1 person
clapping

more loudly
2 people yelling

most loudly
3 or more
people singing
at a concert
