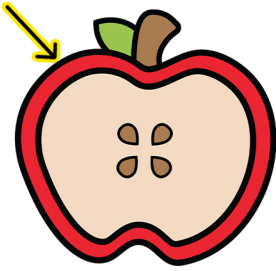


PARTS OF AN APPLE VOCABULARY CARDS



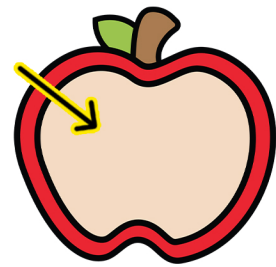
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skin

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The smooth, thin outer covering of an apple. It keeps the inside safe and comes in red, green, or yellow.

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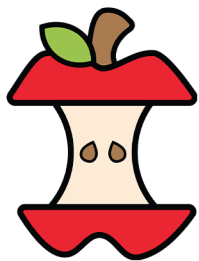
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flesh

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The crisp, juicy part inside the apple that we eat. It is usually white or light yellow.

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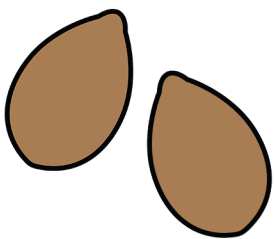
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core

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The tough center of the apple. It holds everything in the middle together and is not usually eaten.

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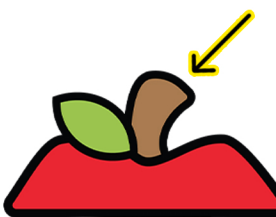
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seeds

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The tiny brown ovals tucked inside the core. Each one could grow into a brand-new apple tree!

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stem

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The short, thin stick at the top of the apple. It connects the apple to the branch of the tree.

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
