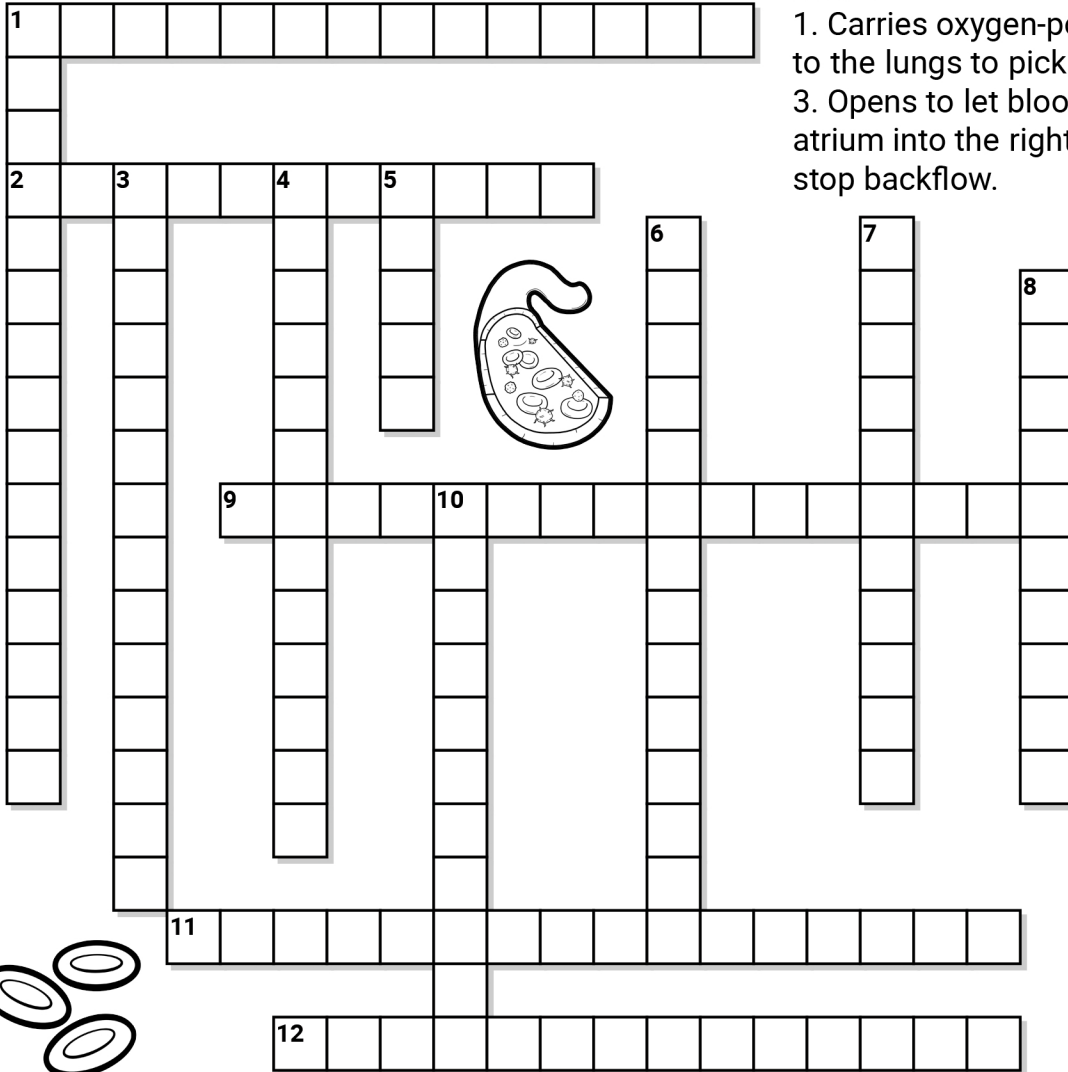


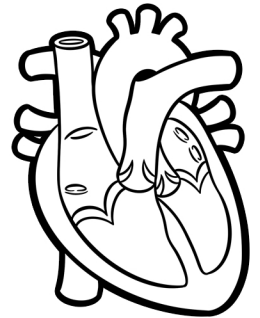
HUMAN HEART

Down

1. Carries oxygen-poor blood from the heart to the lungs to pick up oxygen.
3. Opens to let blood flow from the right atrium into the right ventricle, then closes to stop backflow.



Down (cont...)

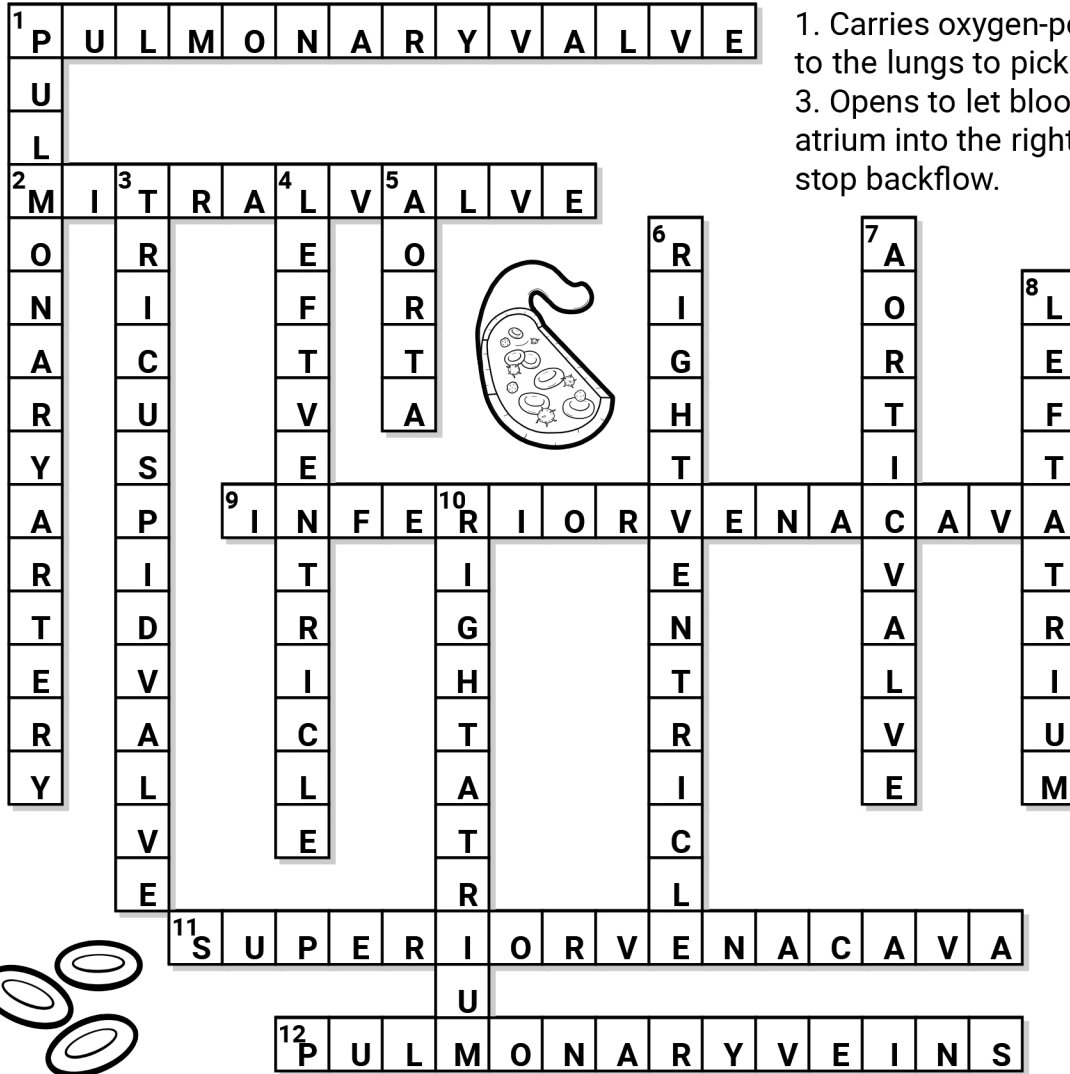
4. Pumps oxygen-rich blood out to the entire body through the aorta.
5. The large artery that carries oxygen-rich blood from the heart out to the body.
6. Pumps oxygen-poor blood to the lungs through the pulmonary artery.
7. Opens to let blood leave the left ventricle into the aorta, then closes to stop it from flowing backward.
8. Receives oxygen-rich blood coming from the lungs and pumps it into the left ventricle.
10. Receives oxygen-poor blood returning from the body and pumps it into the right ventricle.

Across

1. Opens to let blood flow from the right ventricle into the pulmonary artery, then closes to stop backflow.
2. Opens to let blood flow from the left atrium into the left ventricle, then closes to stop backflow.
9. The large vein that returns oxygen-poor blood from the lower body to the heart.
11. The large vein that returns oxygen-poor blood from the upper body to the heart.
12. Carry oxygen-rich blood from the lungs back to the heart.

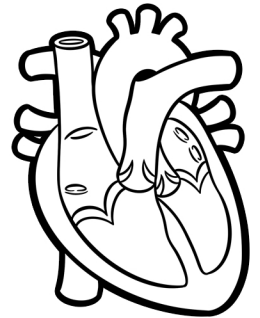


Across

Down

3. Opens to let blood flow from the right atrium into the right ventricle, then closes to stop backflow.

4. Pumps oxygen-rich blood out to the entire body through the aorta.
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
