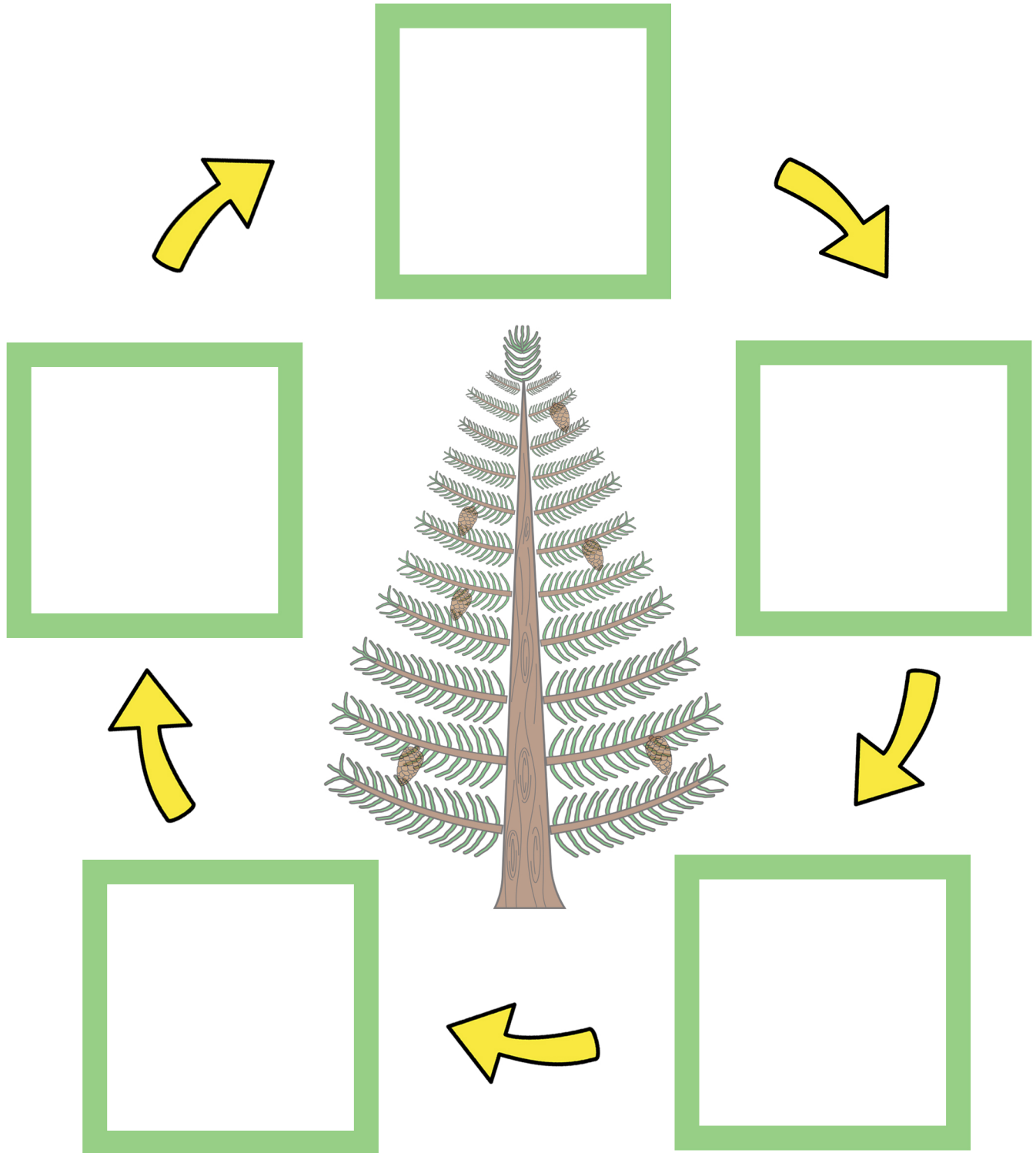

LIFE CYCLE OF A PINE TREE



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seed

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A tiny seed tucked inside the scales of a pine cone. When conditions are right, it falls out and can grow into a new pine tree.

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seedling

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A tiny young pine tree that has just sprouted from a seed. It has a small stem and soft, short needles just beginning to grow.

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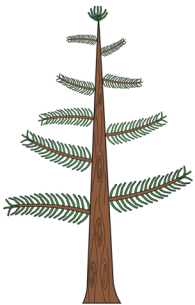
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sapling

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A young pine tree that is growing taller with more needles and small branches. It is still growing and not yet fully mature.

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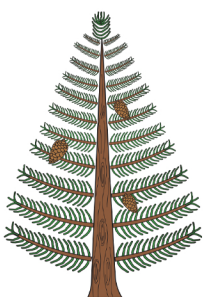
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young pine

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A pine tree that is growing stronger with a thicker trunk and longer branches covered in green needles.

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mature pine

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A fully grown pine tree with a tall trunk, dense branches of needles, and cones that hold seeds for the next generation.

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
