

SIMPLE & COMPLETE PREDICATES

The predicate tells what the subject does, is, or has. It always contains a verb.

SIMPLE PREDICATE

THE MAIN
VERB

EXAMPLE:

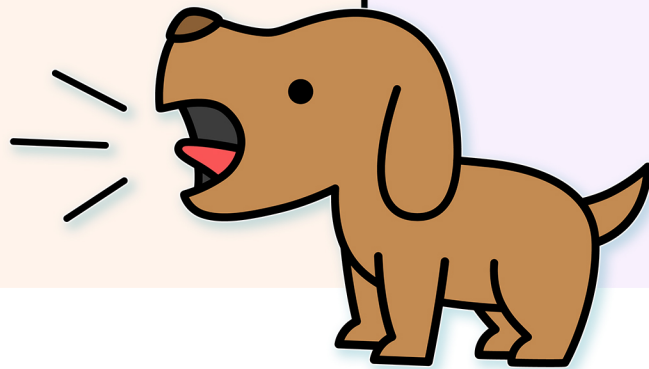
The big dog
barked loudly.

COMPLETE PREDICATE

THE VERB + ALL
OTHER WORDS

EXAMPLE:

The big dog
barked loudly.



TIP:

ASK "WHAT DOES THE SUBJECT DO?"
TO FIND THE PREDICATE.
