A complete sentence needs BOTH
a **subject** AND a **predicate**.

SUBJECT
(Who or what?)

PREDICATE
(What does it do?)

The spotted dog ran across the yard.

My little sister loves strawberry ice cream.

Three noisy blue jays sat on the fence.

FRAGMENT — missing a subject or predicate

"RAN ACROSS THE YARD." → MISSING SUBJECT

"THE SPOTTED DOG." → MISSING PREDICATE
