

PARTS OF A LADYBUG VOCABULARY CARDS



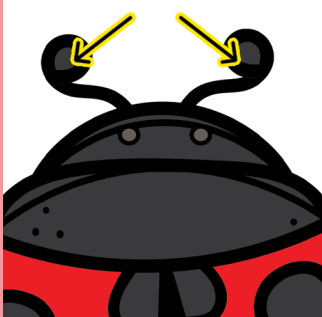
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head

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The front part of the ladybug where its eyes and antennae are.

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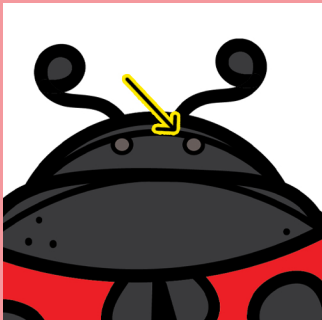
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antennae

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Two thin, bendy parts that help the ladybug touch, smell, and feel.

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eyes

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The two round parts that help the ladybug see.

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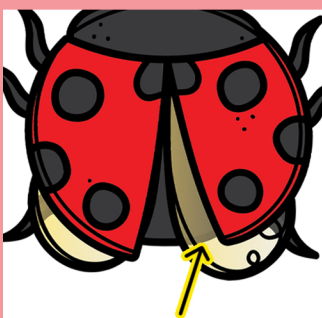
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legs

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The six thin parts a ladybug uses to walk and climb.

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wings

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The soft, see-through parts folded under the hard shell; used for flying.

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spots

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The small black dots on a ladybug's back.

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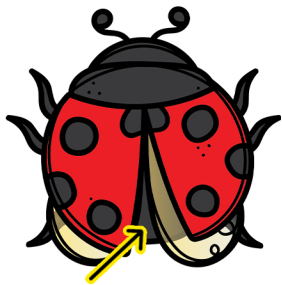
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thorax

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The middle part of the body, between the head and abdomen.

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abdomen

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The back part of the body that holds parts needed to breathe and digest food.

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elytra

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The hard, spotted shell that protects the flying wings underneath.

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
