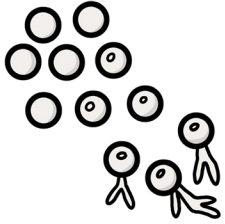
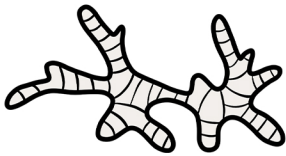

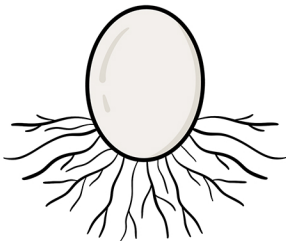
spores

Tiny dust-like specks made by a mushroom that can grow into a brand-new fungus.



spore germination

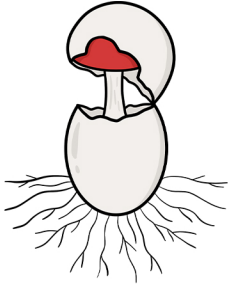
The moment a tiny reproductive speck begins to grow into new threads.



mycelium

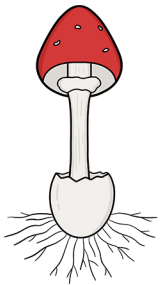
A web of thread-like strands that grows underground and feeds the mushroom.

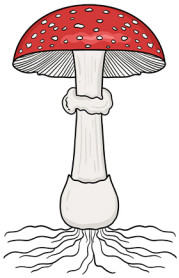
pinhead

A very small, round bump that forms before a mushroom grows bigger.



fruiting
body

The part of a fungus that grows above ground — what we usually call "the mushroom."



mature
mushroom

A fully grown mushroom that is ready to release new reproductive dust.
