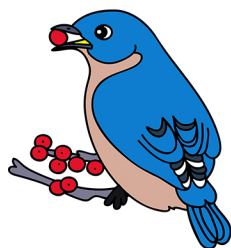


HOW SEEDS TRAVEL

Seed Dispersal Methods



animal (eaten)

Animals eat fruit and deposit seeds in droppings.



animal (hitchhiking)

Seeds with hooks cling to fur or clothing.



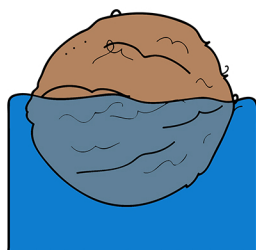
self-dispersal

Seed pods build pressure and explode, launching seeds outward.



wind

Seeds with wings or feathery tufts float through the air.



water

Seeds with waterproof or buoyant coatings float to new places.



gravity

Heavy seeds fall straight down from the parent plant.
