

LEAVES VOCABULARY CARDS



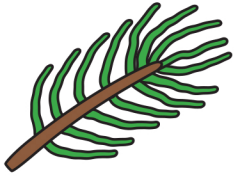
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deciduous

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A type of tree that loses all of its leaves in the fall and grows new ones in spring.

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evergreen

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A type of tree that keeps its leaves all year long and stays green in every season.

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**simple
leaf**

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A leaf that has one single blade attached to a petiole.

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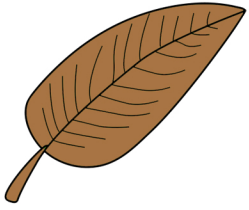
**compound
leaf**

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A leaf made up of several smaller leaflets all attached to one petiole.

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smooth
margin

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A leaf edge that is flat and even with no bumps, points, or cuts.

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toothed
margin

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A leaf edge that has small, sharp points along it like the teeth of a saw.

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lobed
margin

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A leaf edge that has rounded or pointed bumps that curve in and out like fingers.
