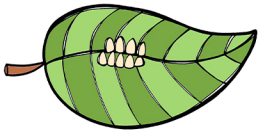
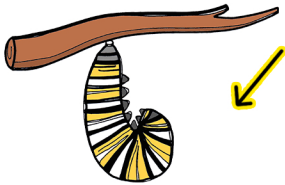


BUTTERFLY LIFE CYCLE VOCABULARY CARDS



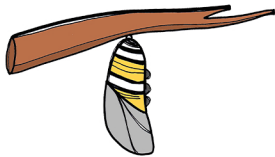
egg

The tiny, oval starting point of a butterfly's life, usually laid on a leaf.



larva

A worm-like young insect that hatches from an egg and eats a lot to grow.



pupa

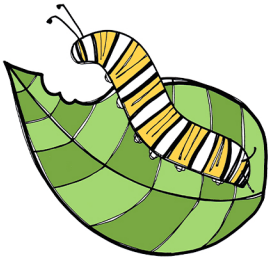
A resting phase where an insect's body rebuilds itself inside a protective case.



adult
butterfly

A fully grown butterfly with wings, ready to fly and lay eggs.

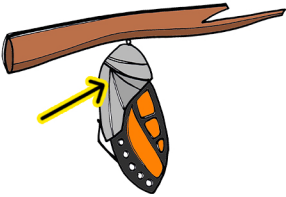
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caterpillar

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The common name for a butterfly's larva — a soft, worm-like creature covered in tiny bristles.

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chrysalis

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The hard, smooth case a caterpillar forms to protect itself while it changes into a butterfly.

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metamorphosis

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The complete change in body form that some insects go through as they grow.

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
