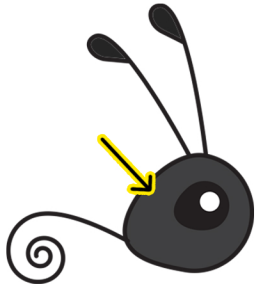


# PARTS OF A BUTTERFLY VOCABULARY CARDS

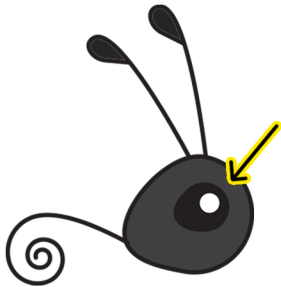


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head

The front part of a butterfly's body where its eyes and antennae are.

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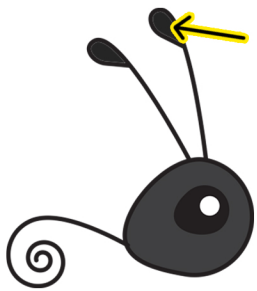


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eye

The part a butterfly uses to see; butterflies have two large compound eyes.

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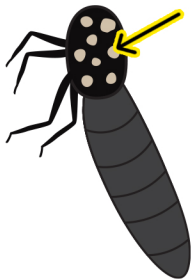


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antenna

One of two long, thin feelers on a butterfly's head that help it smell and balance.

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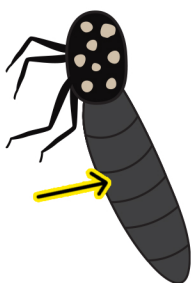


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thorax

The middle part of a butterfly's body where the wings and legs attach.

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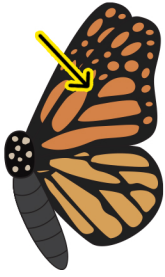
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abdomen

The long back part of a butterfly's body.

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# PARTS OF A BUTTERFLY VOCABULARY CARDS

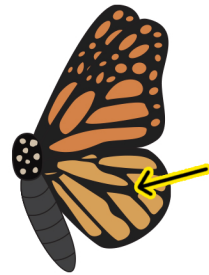


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forewing

The pair of wings closest to a butterfly's head.

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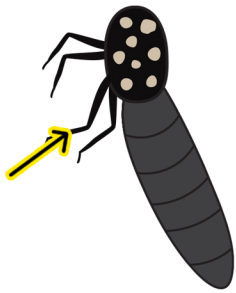


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hindwing

The pair of wings closest to a butterfly's tail end.

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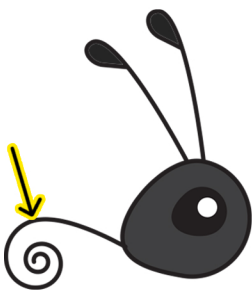


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legs

The six thin parts a butterfly uses to stand and grip onto flowers.

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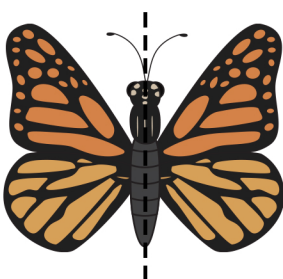


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proboscis

A long, curly tube a butterfly uses like a straw to drink nectar.

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symmetry

When both sides of something match exactly, like a butterfly's wings.

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
