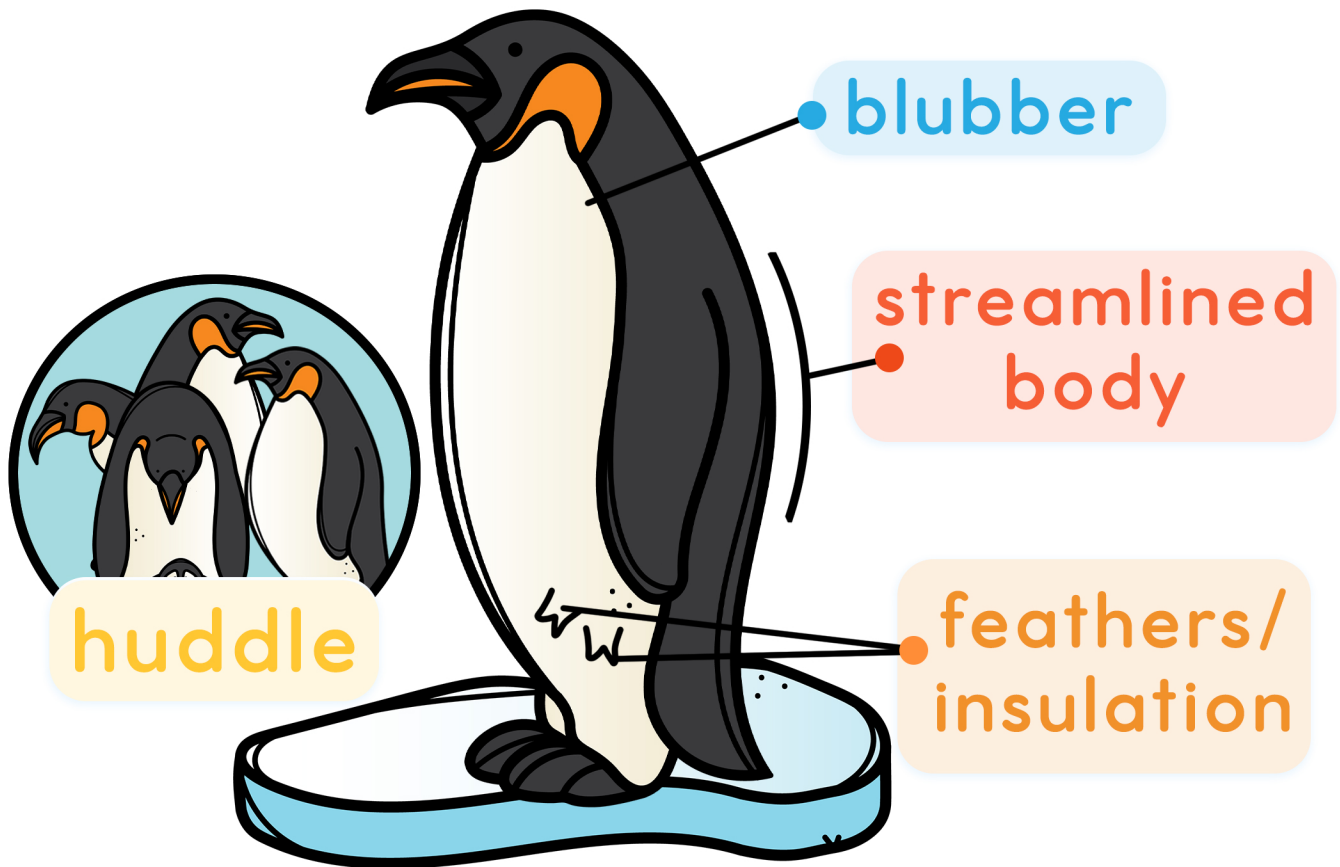


How PENGUINS

Survive the Cold



Blubber: A thick layer of fat under a penguin's skin that helps keep it warm in icy water.

Streamlined body: Shaped smoothly to move through water with very little drag.

Feather/insulation: Block out the cold and hold in warmth.

Huddle: To crowd close together in a group for warmth, the way penguins do in freezing wind.
