

PARTS OF A PENGUIN VOCABULARY CARDS



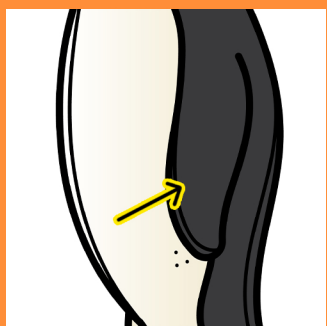
beak

The hard, pointed part of a penguin's mouth used to catch and eat fish.



eye

The body part a penguin uses to see fish, other penguins, and danger nearby.



flipper

A flat, paddle-shaped part that used to be a wing, now used for swimming instead of flying.



feather

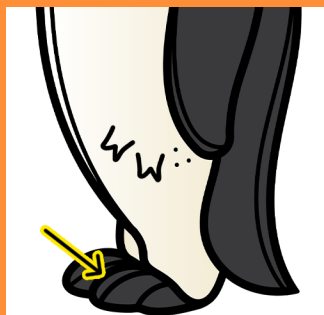
A soft but tightly packed covering that keeps a penguin warm and dry.

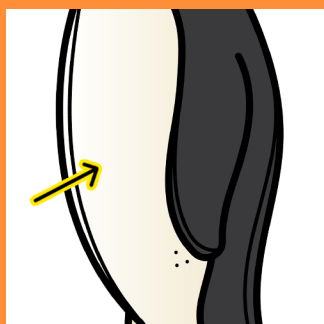
tail

The short, stiff part at the back that helps a penguin balance while standing and steer while swimming.



webbed feet

Feet with skin stretched between the toes, used like paddles to push a penguin through the water.



belly

The white front part of a penguin's body, often used for sliding on ice and snow.
