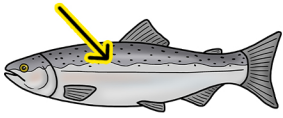


PARTS OF A SALMON VOCABULARY CARDS



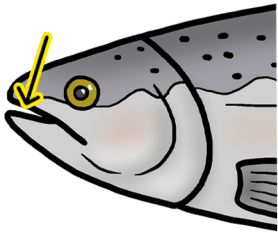
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body

can see and touch.

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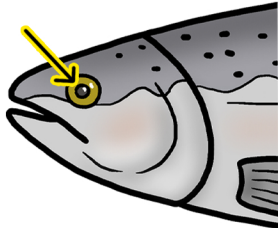
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mouth

pull in water.

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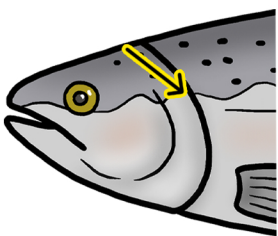
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eyes

to see underwater.

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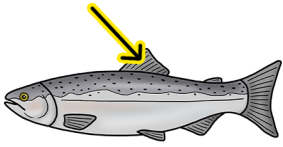
gills

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The body part that lets a
salmon breathe by taking
oxygen from the water.

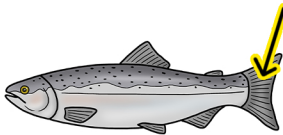
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PARTS OF A SALMON VOCABULARY CARDS



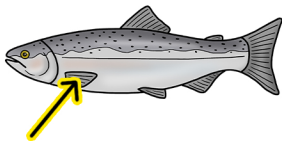
dorsal
fin

The fin on top of a salmon's back that helps it stay upright while swimming.



tail
fin

The fin at the back of a salmon that pushes it forward through the water.



pectoral
fin

The pair of fins on the sides of a salmon's body that help it steer and stop.
